Committee Job Descriptions

Affiliate Committee: Any Affiliate member who would like to support the Real Estate Industry and the Realtor Membership. The Chairperson of the Affiliate Committee Serves as a voting Director on the Board of Directors for 2 year term.

Community Service: To promote the positive Realtor image in the community. Assist in planning functions for Charitable Foundation. Each County has its own Foundation representatives.

Continuing Education: This Committee works with office staff to schedule classes offering interesting and exciting education to area Realtors, at reasonable fees, while financially supporting its own programs.

Diversity: Studies ways and determines means to assist Members and our communities in celebrating the differences of cultural diversities. Host at least one event during the year.

Equal Opportunity in Housing: Studies ways and determines means to assist members and the community. Raises member and public awareness of rights and **responsibilities of equal opportunity in housing**. Host at least one event during the year.
